ORDINANCE NO. 302

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19-61 OF CHAPTER 19 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF HAVANA PERTAINING TO TRIP CHARGES; PROVIDING THAT SUCH TRIP CHARGE SHALL BE IN AN AMOUNT AS DETERMINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AND ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVANA, FLORIDA: SECTION 1. That Section 19-61 of Chapter 19 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Havana is hereby amended to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 19. UTILITIES

Sec. 19-61. Trip Charge.

"When the Town sends an employee to notify the customer of a delinquent bill or a returned check, a service charge in an amount determined by the Town Council and on file in the office of the Town Clerk will be applied for each trip."

SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Town and it is hereby provided that the provisions of this ordinance shall be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Havana, Florida; that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention; and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as required by law.
